*Wer nicht fragt, bleibt dumm!*

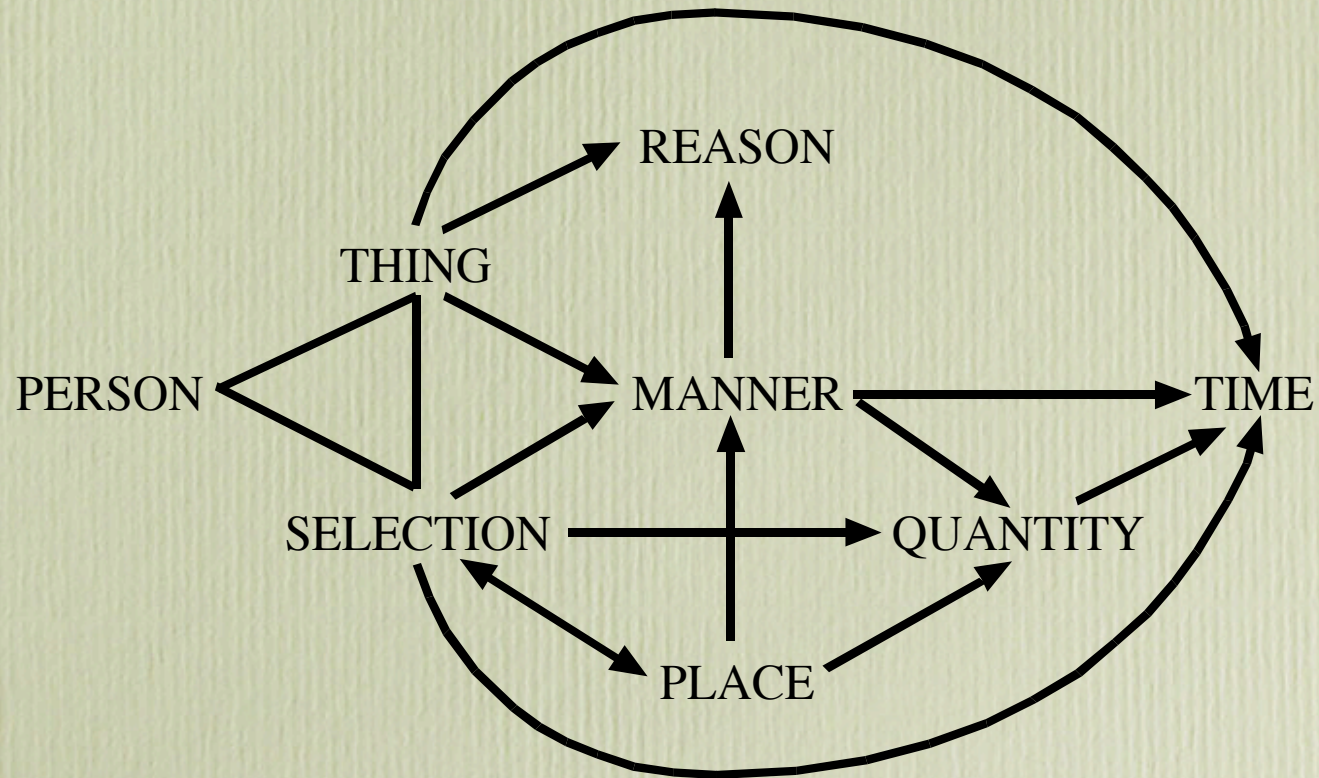


# Typology of form

- unanalyzable morpheme (*how*, but also *who*)
- diachronically analyzable (*why*, *weshalb*)
- analyzable but nonsense semantically (*wofür*)
- partly analyzable ('raspberry'-type)
- transparently derived from another questionword  
(*how much*)
- identical to another questionword  
(*how long?* vs. *how did you do it?*)

# Conclusions

- Synchronically, transparency is ubiquitous
- Diachronically, there is a high 'turn-over rate'
- Extreme transparency is rare
- Extreme ambiguity does not seem to exist
- Ambiguities among major categories are rare
- Ambiguity *who* = *what* is relatively common
